Blanding City Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) First Public Hearing Notice

Notice is hereby given that Blanding City will hold a Public Hearing on Tuesday, November 26, 2024 at the Blanding City Office Building, 50 W 100 W, Blanding, UT at 7:00 PM. Blanding City is eligible to apply to the Utah Department of Workforce Services for funding under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Small Cities Program, a federally funded program administered by the State of Utah, House and Community Development Division (HCD). Blanding City is eligible to apply for CDBG funding provided Blanding City meets the applicable program requirements. The purpose of the public hearing is to provide citizens with pertinent information about the Community Development Block Grant program and allow for discussion of possible applications. This public hearing will cover eligible activities, program requirements, and expected funding allocations in the region. The CDBG Program can fund a broad range of activities, including, but not limited to: construction of public works and facilities, e.g., water and sewer lines, fire stations, acquisition of real property, and provision of public services such as food banks, or homeless shelters. In the event that Blanding City chooses to apply for CDBG funding, a second public hearing will be held at a later time to discuss the project.
