Dear Little Miss Blanding Contestant and Parent/Guardian:

On behalf of Blanding City and the pageant committee, we would like to thank you for entering the pageant. We are excited to host a fun event and can't wait to show off how fabulous your daughter is to our community!

The following is a schedule of events and also further information regarding the pageant:

1. Applications - must be received by March 25, 2023 by 5:00pm to the City Office (50 W 100 S). No exceptions.
2. MANDATORY meeting with contestants and parent/guardian with pageant committee on **March 30, 2023** at 7 pm at the Blanding City Office building. (50 W 100 S)
3. OPTIONAL Workshops to help with pageant prep. They will be at the SJSH Auditorium:

April 18th - Interview, **May 16th** - Walking, **June 13th** - Talent and general run through of events. (Contestants will be given numbers at this time as well as the on stage interview questions that will be asked.)

4. Photos – Brooke Pehrson will be taking a few head shots of each contestant **May 15, 2023**. We will let you know the location close to the date. The photo will be taken for the San Juan Record, the Pageant Program and any advertising that we do for the pageant. By signing the disclosure, you agree to allow your daughter's picture made public - to be in the paper and posted around town. Contestants can wear whatever makes them feel comfortable, be advised, these will be presented to the public and girls should dress accordingly.
5. Pageant Structure – Little Miss Blanding competition will consist of 3 judged categories, and 1 non-judged portion. The non-judged portion will be an opening number that all contestants will be asked to participate in. The judged categories will be as follows: 1. Talent - this can be any type of talent, the sky is the limit! Girls will not be judged based on each other's talents or judged against each other, but by the contestant's performance only to themselves. Talent's must be 2 minutes total. Deduction of points if contestant goes over time. 2. Formal wear - each girl will be asked to provide an escort of her choice. 3. On stage interview - this will be a 3 question interview/conversation with each contestant and the MC. You will know ahead of time all 10 questions that could be asked.
6. MANDATORY dress rehearsal **June 16, 2023**. This will be held in the San Juan High School Auditorium at 7 pm.
7. Pageant – **June 17, 2023** at San Juan High School Auditorium. Please be there by 6:00 pm.
8. After the pageant, the new Little Miss Blanding and all attendants will need to stay for pictures for a few minutes.
9. Responsibilities - The Blanding 4th of July parade will be held on **July 4, 2023**. If your child is chosen as Little Miss Blanding Royalty, she will be riding in the parade and may run games at Centennial Park or helping the city with anything they may need that day. It is possible the royalty will do something during the 24th of July and/or the San Juan County fair or any other days the city may want to incorporate the Royalty. Little Miss Blanding Disclosure

1. The pageant is limited to girls that turn 10 before July 1, 2023 and don't turn 13 before July 1, 2023, and contestants must reside in Blanding.
2. The Little Miss Blanding Committee requests the Little Miss Blanding royalty to be available when needed without having other obligations that would inhibit them from being able to help.
3. All contestants and parent/guardian must try to attend all meetings and practices. Mandatory events must be attended, or forfeit may be in order at the disclosure of the director. These additional practices will only be for the benefit of each contestant and will be helpful to their success. If a conflict arises, please call Lacey Ivins to let her know that your child will be late or will not be able to make it. There will be no makeup meetings/practices.
4. Little Miss Blanding competition will consist of 3 judged portions - talent, formal wear and on stage interview. Each Contestant will also participate in a (non-judged) introduction number.
5. Contestants are expected to arrive at the SJHS auditorium by 6pm on June 17th ready for the pageant to begin promptly at 7pm. We want each contestant to pick a FEMALE backstage helper. This can be anyone that is comfortable to the girl and who will be helpful in changing outfits, helping fix hair/makeup and most importantly encouraging their contestant. We would like it to be someone other than a parent. This way parents can relax and enjoy their daughter's performance from the audience.
6. Judging will be conducted by a panel of judges. Their decisions are final. A Little Miss Blanding Queen will be nominated and the royalty will consist of runners up based on number of pageant participants.
7. In the event of a tie, LMB official procedures will be used. We will go to scores from talent. Winner is based on the higher score in the talent portion.
8. Contestants are not allowed to give any gifts to the judges such as roses, candy, etc., or touch the judges as they walk by. Violation will result in disqualification.
9. Contestants will be judged on a scale of 1-10 with 10 being the highest and a 30 as the highest score attainable. They will be judged in the categories of talent, appearance, talking abilities, personality, stage presence and **most importantly** confidence.
10. All contestants will be asked three onstage questions which will be given out at the pageant practice. The list will include 10 questions but contestants will only answer 3 onstage.
11. The Blanding 4th of July parade will be held on **July 4, 2023**. If your child is chosen as Little Miss Blanding royalty, she will be riding in the parade and may run games at Centennial Park or helping the city with anything they may need that day. It is possible the royalty will do something during the 24th of July and/or the San Juan County fair. Additional details will be given out after the pageant. It is possible, we may have them help with an event that arises through the year in our community.
12. If for any reason Little Miss Blanding cannot fulfill her duties, the 1st Runner-ups will be promoted.
13. The parent agrees that if their child is selected as Little Miss Blanding, they will serve until their successor has been selected and remains bound by these rules for the term of their reign.
