



Public Notice of Mid-Term Blanding City Council Vacancy Request for Application of Appointment

Public Notice is hereby given of a Mid-Term Vacancy due to the recent resignation of Councilmember Kd Perkins. All interested citizens of Blanding City are invited to apply for appointment to the Council by meeting eligibility and residency requirements. The appointed City Councilmember will serve through the first Monday of January 2024.

Eligibility and Residency Requirements:

- 1) Candidates must be a United States citizen at the time of filing for candidacy.
- 2) Candidates must be at least 18 years of age.
- 3) Candidates must be a legal resident of Blanding City for 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the date of appointment.
- 4) Candidates must be a registered voter of Blanding City.
- 5) If selected, the Candidate must maintain a principal place of residence within the City of Blanding during their term.

In accordance with Utah Constitution Article IV, Section 6, any mentally incompetent person, any person convicted of a felony, or any person convicted of treason or a crime against the elective franchise may not hold office in this state until the right to hold elective office is restored under 20A-2-101.5 of the Utah Code.
